Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognise and understand some familiar words and phrases in written form</li> <li>Read aloud some familiar sounds, phonemes and word</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read and understand some familiar words and phrases and pronounce them accurately</li> <li>Read a wider range of words, phrases and sentences aloud</li> <li>Follow text while listening and reading at the same time</li> <li>Apply phonic knowledge to support reading new words, phrases and sentences aloud with increasingly accurate pronunciation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read and understand some of the main points from a short text</li> <li>Read different genres of writing</li> <li>Recognise how cognates can help to understand new language</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read aloud from a text with good expression</li> <li>Read and understand the main points and some detail from a short written passage</li> </ul>
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write some familiar simple words using a model and some from memory</li> <li>Know how to find words in a bi-lingual dictionary</li> <li>Understand that nouns can be masculine and feminine</li> <li>Understand word order of adjectives</li> <li>Understand how to form the negative</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write a short text using a model</li> <li>Write a few simple sentences from memory</li> <li>Apply phonic knowledge to support writing</li> <li>Be able to form simple sentences using the appropriate gender, adjective noun placement and persons</li> <li>Recognise when a sentence is negative</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write simple sentences and short texts using a model</li> <li>Know how to write a letter</li> <li>Know how to make a sentence negative</li> <li>Know that adjectives agree with the noun</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognise that adjectives have feminine and masculine forms. Learn how to conjugate regular 'er' verbs</li> <li>Recognise the most familiar, irregular verbs (to be, to have)</li> <li>Understand and begin to use the past tense to describe events</li> <li>Know how to write a letter using correct formality</li> </ul>
