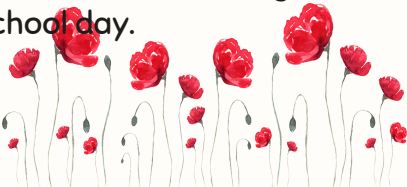
PARENTS' EVENINGS

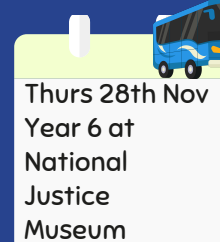
