### CELEBRATING ABBEYHILLIAN BEHAVIOUR

Listening to pupil voice is important and we have taken lots of their feedback on our behaviour policy. We have made some minor changes to our 'consequences and rewards' and our new proud chart can be seen here.

#### Rewards:

Pupils move on the PROUD Chart, earning Dojos and Gold rewards for good behaviour choices. In each term: 1 Gold Dojo earns access to a Gold Activity, 5 Gold Dojos earn a Golden Playtime, and 15 Gold Dojos allow pupils to choose a book.

#### Consequences:

We start with a simple, verbal reminder. If behaviour persists, a pupil may move to Yellow (a formal warning), then Amber (a playtime reflection). Continued wrong choices or serious incidents result in Red, involving the Behaviour Team and may lead to behaviour monitoring cards. Communicating with parents, about these, is important to us.

Pupils can move back across the board as they make good choices during the day.



### FIRST AID CHANGES

This will be introduced after half-term.

We recently updated our First Aid policy. We always make sure to keep parents informed if their child has received first aid at school.

For minor injuries, we will send a message via email.

If a child has a bump to the head or a significant injury, we will call you to let you know.
