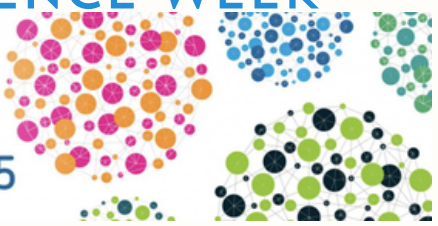
ATTENDANCE UPDATE
