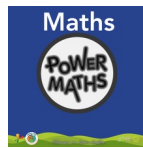

We'll be developing our diary writing skills and also learning how to persuade our audience as to who's the greatest Roman God!



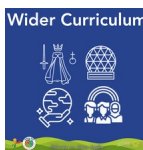
Maths
