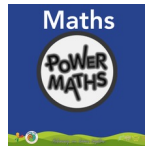


Happy New Year to you all and welcome back to Year 6!

We will be writing a dialogue based on the picture book 'The Arrival' and a non-chronological report all about Crime and Punishment through the ages.



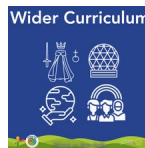
Maths
