MOBILE PHONES



MOBILE PHONES IN SCHOOL

We recognise some pupils, particularly older pupils, may need a mobile phone when travelling to and from school.

IF YOU BRING A MOBILE PHONE TO SCHOOL:

- 1. SWITCH IT OFF**
The phone must be switched off before entering the school site.
- 2. HAND IT IN**
The phone must be handed to the school office immediately upon arrival.
- 3. COLLECT IT**
The phone must be collected from the school office at the end of the school day.

NOT ALLOWED DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

- Pupils must not carry mobile phones on their person, in their bags or in classrooms during the school day.
- Smart watches with communication, camera or internet capability are treated as mobile devices and are not permitted.
